Before the first light of day

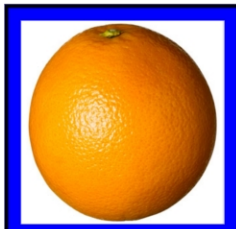
Rose up, perhaps without a cause

Device that limits movement, such as a seat belt or a set of handcuffs

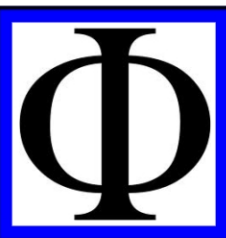
Capital of New Mexico
