The 20 clues below identify items from different complete sets of 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 items, not in any particular order. (Well, the clues are alphabetized, but not the answers.) One item from each set is not clued. Answer the 20 clues (each is a 1-word answer), then figure out what the sets are and provide the missing set items (one per set, in any order) in spaces 21-25 at the bottom. Scoring is 1 point for every correct answer, for a maximum score of 25.

NOTES: (1) one listed answer typically is preceded by a particular (unclued) adjective when appearing in its set; (2) the spelling of one listed answer will not exactly match its usual spelling when appearing as a member of its set; (3) one of the missing set members will contain 3 words (the rest will be 1 word each).

10	Last name of brothers who founded a British soap company that merged with Margarine Unie to form a portmanteau-ed multinational conglomerate	
11	Last name of the last competitor to be eliminated in the film <i>Willy Wonka and the Chocolate Factory</i>	
12	Name of the first Pope (do not include "Saint")	
13	Not-usually-musical item used as an instrument in Verdi's famous chorus from <i>Il Trovatore</i>	
14	Tab, Holly, and Catfish, among others	
15	The word "recto" refers to a right-hand one (just as a "verso" is a left-hand one)	
16	Tool depicted on the shirt of Nathan Fillion's hero character in <i>Dr. Horrible's Sing-Along Blog</i>	
17	Type of geometry that is the counterpart to solid geometry	
18	Word in titles of Billboard #1 hits from Orbison, Sledge, and The Guess Who	
19	Word that can be paired with SAND, ISSUE, or SALAD to make three common 2-word phrases	
20	Word that fills the blank in the title of a Warner Brothers Merrie Melodies cartoon: ____ <i>Dodgers in the 24½th Century</i>
